


"Hi there! I'm Dory. And I'm a fish on a mission.


HINT: Read about the different sharks in Bruce's Shark World to find the clues that mention Dory's friend.

Even though they might look like plants, corals are animals!






"Guess what? I remember I have two more friends who live in the **Undersea Viewing Area!"**


He reminds me of Bruce, so what memories he'll spark!
